

How to send photos for a useful estimate

A good inquiry saves time and reduces risk. Send enough information so the work can be understood before a written offer is prepared.

1. Send the basic information first

Send the property location, type of property, short description of the desired works, preferred timing and whether the property is occupied or empty.

For inquiries related to Osijek, Zadar, Šibenik, Dalmatia or other Croatian locations, logistics and access can influence the estimate.

If the project is for a rental apartment, holiday property or foreign-owned house, state whether you can be present on site or whether the work must be coordinated remotely.

2. Send photos that show the real condition

Take photos of the whole room, every wall, floor, ceiling, existing installations, access to the property and details that may affect the work.

For bathrooms, include photos of tiles, sanitary zones, drains, water points, ceiling, door area and any visible damage.

For apartments and houses, include rooms, corridors, stair access, exterior access, waste removal path and any area where furniture or materials must be carried.

3. Explain the scope, not only the result you want

Describe what should be removed, what should remain, what material is already selected and which details are not decided yet.

A useful estimate depends on scope, substrate, demolition, waste, access, material status, finish level and timing.

If you have drawings, moodboards, measurements or a list of works, send them with the inquiry.

4. How we use your inquiry

[WhatsApp](#) is used for quick first contact and photo sharing. The [web form](#) or [e-mail](#) is better for a structured inquiry and a written offer.

After reviewing the information, we may ask additional questions or propose a site visit when the risk cannot be assessed from photos alone.

The goal is not to send a random number, but to prepare a clear and comparable basis for decision-making.
